#### Feature Topic: Multi-view photogrammetry

We collaborate with DigitalGlobe to provide high-resolution 3D map up to 50cm resolution. Our high resolution 3D map is generated by using the "Multi-view photogrammetry" technology, the most innovative technologies, including a combination of high-resolution satellite imageries taken from multiple angles.

This technology enables us to generate a 3D map with higher accuracy compared to traditional stereo-based technique.

## Application of the Month: Natural Resources/Mining
