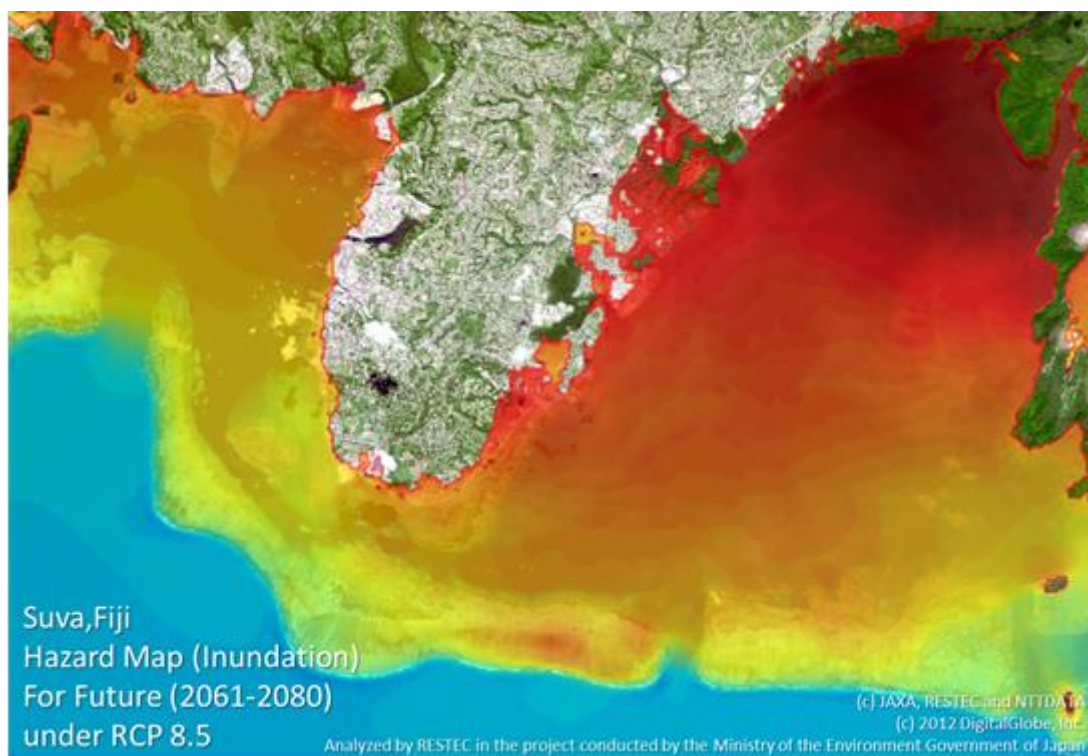
Normally air temperatures begin to drop sharply from October in Japan, but it has been still hotter than usual even though autumn has already started.

Feature Topic: [Use Case] Hazard maps for high tides caused by cyclones (Fiji etc.)



In the island countries, hazard maps have not been developed, but it is really required in Fiji, Vanuatu and Samoa where have the highest vulnerability to cyclones damage in the Asia Pacific. Utilizing AW3D Standard product (5m resolution) and water depth data derived from optical satellite imageries(WorldView-2 etc.), they carried out flood analysis on coastal regions, and finally affected areas by accelerating climate change were pointed out in hazard maps prominently (indicated in the figure above).
